~ WHITE ~

Schramsberg, *Blanc de Noirs* North Coast, CA 2011 98

In 1965, Jack and Jamie Davies established Schramsberg on property originally owned by Jacob Schram, setting out to make world class sparkling wine to match the prestige and quality of French Champagne. To this day, Schramsberg stands unrivaled in California, with a fine example of a Pinot Noir-dominated wine, showing classic creamy, round, yet gentle fruit notes exhibited by the varietal. The Chardonnay flashes a little bit of “zing” to match the full-body mouthfeel.

Simon Bize, *Chardonnay “Les Perrières”* Bourgogne AOC, France 2011 105

For over 20 years, this Savigny-lès-Beaune estate was led by Patrick Bize until his sudden passing in 2013. His legacy of consistent winemaking continued through his wife, Chisa Bize, and she retained the use of organic and biodynamic practices throughout their wines. These methods impart an aromatic, elegant, medium-bodied wine, showcasing limestone, citrus zest, white flowers, and a hint of oak spice on the palate.

Mönchhof, *Riesling Spätlese, Ürziger Würzgarten* Mosel, Germany 2015 78

An old German estate, Mönchhof has vineyard holdings dating back to the 12th century, when monks owned this land. The “Ürziger Würzgarten”, or Spice Garden, vineyard’s name is well earned, as it is mainly comprised of iron-rich red slate, giving the wine a minerality unlike any other along the Mosel River. Ripe aromas of exotic fruit, white peach, and pineapple are coupled with notes of cinnamon and clove. Density and richness on the palate makes this off-dry Riesling an absolute pleasure to sip with sushi, Asian plates, or completely on its own!

~ RED ~

Domaine de la Côte, *Pinot Noir, Bloom’s Field* Santa Rita Hills, CA 2014 130

Born from an alliance between Sashi Moorman (Evening Land) and Sommelier Raj Parr, Domaine de la Côte boasts an impressive résumé of single vineyard sites, with different geology, climate, and elevation. Lying on the western edge of the appellation, Bloom’s Field is grown from iron-rich clay, the wine exhibits striking minerality, along with freshly crushed raspberry and bright strawberry. Earth and smoke give way to a lingering spicy acidity, giving the wine a striking Burgundian edge.

Monte dos Cabaços, *Vinho Tinto* Alentejano, Portugal 2009 55

Often overlooked because of its neighbor to the East, Portugal is not just the land of world-class Port wine. Make no mistake, this Tinto is an Old World gem. A blend of indigenous grapes, mostly Touriga Nacional, this small producer makes a wine of ripe dark fruit, raisins, and dried black fig, complete with an earthy edge and plenty of bottle age, which softens the tannins and makes this food wine absolutely delicious with roasted and braised meats.

Galardi, *Aglianico, “Terra di Lavoro”* Roccamonfina IGT, Italy 2010 150

2010 will be a vintage to remember in all of Italy’s prestigious appellations. Standouts from the classic regions of Piedmont and Tuscany abound, yet recognition is much deserved elsewhere. This Aglianico from Campania is born and raised on the slopes of the Roccamonfina volcano. Produced from a tiny vineyard, it explodes with tar, smoke, graphite, blackberry jam and savory herbs. Intense and full-bodied, with integrated, elegant tannins, it is entering a perfect drinking window.
